## HADATHORAI TEA FACTORY

### TEA LEAVES:

\* Withering is the process of allowing the fresh leaves to dry. Some producers have special withering rooms, whereas others wither their tea in the open air.

\* Rolling twists and breaks the leaves to release the natural juices. This action activates enzymes that help to initiate fermentation. Rolling also gives the leaves a curled appearance.

\* Crushing (or cutting) is an alternative to rolling. It serves the same purpose, but finely chops the leaves instead of breaking them into large pieces. Cutting enables tea to brew quickly and produce a dark infusion.

\* Fermentation is the process of oxidizing green tea leaves to make black and oolong teas. The green leaves are spread out and exposed to the air for three to four hours.

## Drying :-

The primary objective of drying is the extraction of moisture and the arresting of fermentation. It takes about 20 to 25 minutes. The moisture content of the tea after drying completed is approximately 2% to 3% and the fermented tea particles are now back.

## Grading (sifting) :

The dried teas after cooling are graded / sifted according to size and shape as the trade demands.



## Packing / Despatching :-

\* Tea is very hygroscopic and rapidly absorbs moisture. When sufficient quantities of tea are collected, they are either packed in plywood tea chests or multi-walled aluminium craft paper despatched to the auctions or packed into tea packs of various drums for direct export / distribution.

\* An alternative to drinking decoaf is to double brew the leaves. Discard this first batch of tea and pour fresh boiling water over the reused leaves; brew for the prescribed time.

Process : Market access as well as market efficiency is further constrained by the perishability of the products. Unless the market infrastructure and related systems function well, products that are more perishable tend to have relatively lower market efficiency.
