INDUSTRIAL VISIT III B.COM A (12.04.2022-17.04.2022)

On receiving the letter of permission from KG COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE, 45 students along with 2 faculty members (Mrs.D.Mythili and Mrs.A.Nagrathinam) were set out to go for a planned Industrial visit. The journey of the day started with the departure of bus on 12.04.2022 at 10: 30 pm from the college campus. We travelled overnight towards Mysore via Dhimbam. It was a thrilling drive through the forests and by morning of 13.04.2022 we reached Mysore around 8 a.m. We got freshen up and had a brisk breakfast and then we started visiting places.

DAY 1 – MYSORE

1. Saint Philomena's Cathedral – It was one of the largest churches in Asia, we made a visit over there and also had an exciting walk through the caves in the church. We explored lots of historical things which was sculptured in the walls of the church.



2. Chamundeshwari Temple – After having lavish lunch we visited Chamundeshwari temple. There was a breezing weather while traveling through the mountains we saw Lalitha mahal's top view from the hill.
3. Mysore Palace – Then we visited the historical palace and a royal residence called Mysore Palace which was one of our splendid visit which helped us to explore all the ancient monuments which can date back to the 14th century. The throne, sculptures, containers, painting were an eye feast to the visitors.



The day ended up with the stay in a residence located in Mysore.

DAY 2 – COORG

The next day journey started with our travel towards Raja Seat in Coorg at 6:30 pm

1. Raja Seat- It was a beautiful mountain view portraying a dew filled sunrise. It was the most welcoming way to start a day followed by the experience of absolute chilling weather condition.
2. Visit to KAR Enterprise- KAR Enterprise is basically a rice husking and processing unit located in the outskirts of Coorg. We were able to look and study the process of conversion of paddy into the edible rice material for our consumption. There were huge machineries meant to purify the paddy, cleaning it, removing the dust etc.



3. Elephant camp – We had our rafting session through the river of Kaveri. We have learnt to paddle through the force of the water and gained a new courage which is an essential skill to be mastered.



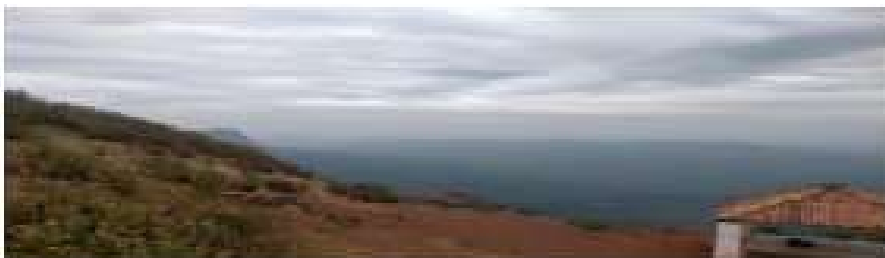
After visiting these places, The DJ night was worth enjoying after a tiresome day of travel. We headed towards Chickmangalur overnight.

DAY 3- CHICKMANGALUR

We reached Chickmangalur around 10 pm this day. All the refreshments were taken and after having a brisk breakfast we were ready to explore the places.

1. Z-point – We reached the z-point view by riding over the mountain through jeep safari. The view was full of forest cover where we came across some exciting animals on our way. The Z- point was reached after having a walk of certain distance on the top most part of the mountain.
2. Mulayangiri peak- The journey towards z- point was followed by our visit to Mulayangiri peak closely located near it. The view is one of the highest point in the chain of mountains present there. It was an amazing view to look at the structure of villages and towns from the top view.

3. Siri coffee- The Siri coffee is regarded as one of the best tourism spot for the visitors to enjoy the privileges of certain refreshments and soulful sip of Coffee.



The day ended with our overnight stay in Chickmangalur.

DAY 4- UDUPI

The next day was headed towards our journey towards Udupi around some 12 pm.

EXPLANATION FOR THE POEM LINES:

Once the help is rendered to the Needy, do not wait for any return of

gratitude, for the coconut palm takes water in its roots, delivers it later as sweet juice at its top.

From this poem, we could understand that when we are helping others, we should not think of when that person will reciprocate it or do it back to us. Whatever may be the quality of water that a palm tree may imbibe with its root, it will always give back only sweet tender juice. Like wise whatever meagre help that you may have done to others, it will definitely come back to you one day in a magnified way.

He further goes on to say that using computers and every kind of technological equipment gives students the sense of freedom and encouragement. With the help of technology students can be active, motivated and involved in the language learning process. Materials which have high quality and authenticity with reasonable price can be provided by technology. In this way, the popularity of distance education increases.

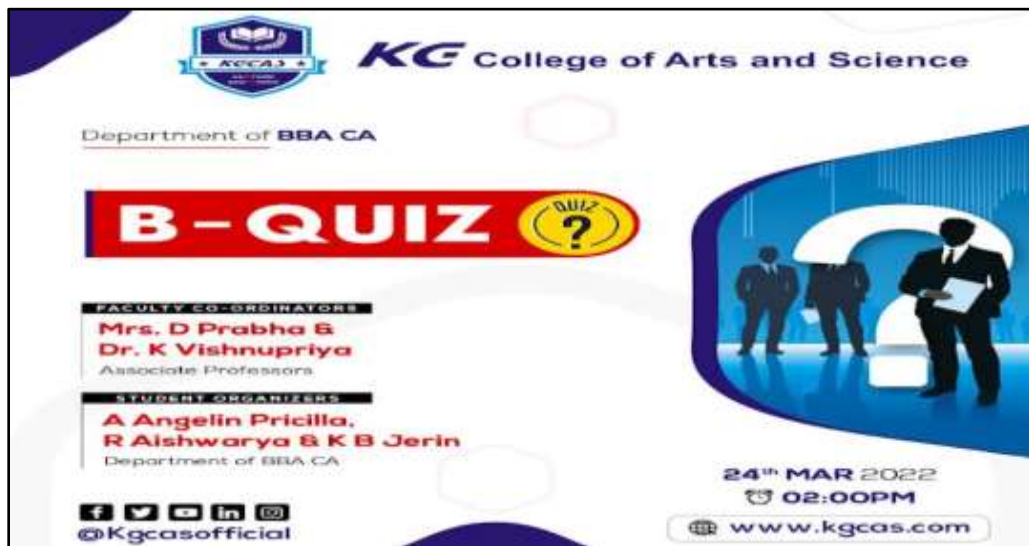

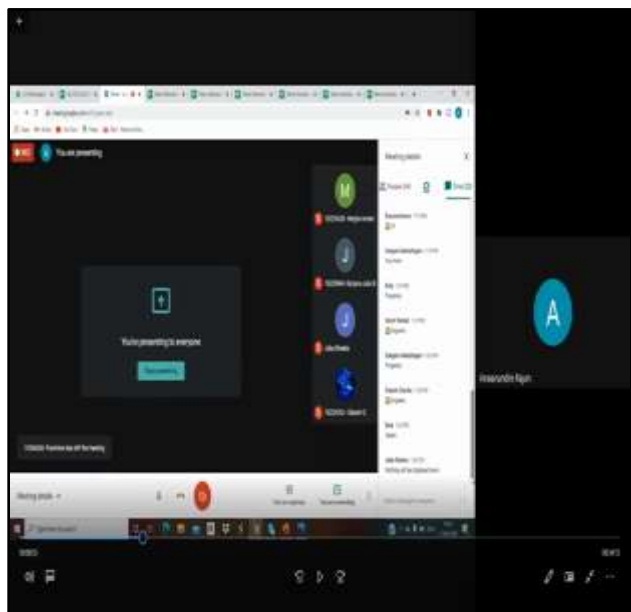
