AND

K.G College of Arts & Science, being the beneficiary of this MoU having its principal place of business at 365, Thudiyalur Road, Saravanampatti, Coimbatore - 641035 duly represented (hereinafter referred to as, K.G College of Arts & Science, Coimbatore which expression shall, wherever the context so permits mean and include successors and assigns.)

WHERE AS

ICT Academy is *interalia* established as a society with Consortium of Government of India, Government of Tamil Nadu and Industry. It is the pioneering venture under the Public-Private-Partnership (PPP) model that endeavours to train the higher education teachers of Tamil Nadu in the areas of Information and Communication Technology (ICT) thereby making their students to be industry-ready.

The core objective of ICT Academy is to train the faculty members of Engineering, Arts and Science Colleges, Polytechnics and ITI's across Tamil Nadu. ICT Academy will develop and maintain a world class ICT industry related curriculum and content in close association with Academia and industry, which would be made available to faculty members throughout the state through an online portal. Industry experts would train the learned faculty to keep them abreast of the industry demands and thereby the students.

The Academy shall have a core team of faculty members to conduct the training. This core team would be supported by faculty members deputed from Industry as well drawn from the educational Institutions.

The ICT Academy is led by a Governing body chaired by Mr.Lakshmi Narayanan Emeritus Vice Chairman, Cognizant Technologies. Other members are Dr. Santhosh Babu IAS Secretary – IT Department, Government Of Tamil Nadu, Thiru. M Vijayakumar IAS, Managing Director, ELCOT, Thiru. Santosh K. Misra IAS, Commissioner, Tamil Nadu E-Governance Agency, Thiru. V.Balakrishnan, Chairman of Micrograam, Thiru.K.Ganesan - Vice President, Human Resources of TCS and Thiru. M. Sivakumar- CEO, ICT Academy.

ICT Academy is agreeable to enter into this MoU with K.G College of Arts & Science, Coimbatore as per the terms and conditions set out hereunder:



Now this MoU witnesses as under:

1. Scope of the MoU

- 1.1 K.G College of Arts & Science, Coimbatore hereby agrees to host the Employability Skill Development Training being offered by ICT Academy.
- 1.2 K.G College of Arts & Science, Coimbatore, would collaborate to implement the Employability Skill Development Training for unemployed youth under the Reliance Home Finance & Reliance Money Social Initiative Project. The program to be implemented is "Skill Training in Financial Literacy" for the final year graduating students / graduated students from the Univeristy.

2 Role of ICT ACADEMY

- 2.1 Shall support on students acquisition and screening process for the selection of students for the program.
- 2.2 Will provide the template for printing of banner
- 2.3 Shall provide course materials and training kit to the trainees and required training materials to faculty/ trainers
- 2.4 Shall provide training and orientation for the trainers to conduct the training program.
- 2.5 Shall provide trainers/ faculty who will handle the below mentioned modules. The trainer cost will be borne by ICT Academy.
- 2.6 Certification to all the students on successful completion of the training.
- 2.7 Would support in placement facilitation to all successful candidates on completion of the training program.
- 2.8 Shall provide trainers/ faculty who will handle the below mentioned modules. The trainer cost will be borne by ICT Academy.

3 Role of K.G College of Arts & Science, Coimbatore

- 3.1 Shall work along with ICT Academy in acquiring eligible candidates for taking up the Training.
- 3.2 Should take declaration from the student that they will not discontinue the course. If discontinued will pay the course fee to ICT Academy.
- 3.3 Shall appoint one coordinator to coordinate between ICT Academy and trainers until the completion of the Training.
- 3.4 The Training period will be a total of 200Hrs as per the modules of the respective Skill Training launched. Shall ensure to follow the training schedule and ensure the successful completion of training of 200 hours of each batch being launched.
- 3.5 Organise an Inauguration function and cover the training with Photographs & Videos. Shall video shoot atleast 5 students narrating their experience before and after the training.
- 3.6 Shall provide theory and computer lab to conduct the training programme



3.7 Shall assure trainers /faculty members and trainees to be regular in attendance and abide by the process and reporting systems of the project, assessments until project completion.

3.8 Submit all acknowledgements and reports as per the requisites of the Project.

4 Payment Terms

4.1 ICT Academy will provide with Rs. 20,000.00 (Rupees Twenty Thousand Only) towards Implementation and conducting the training for each Skill Training Programme launched as per the split up given below.

- a) Rs. 15,000.00/- towards the use of Infrastructure and audio/ Visual room and for the Photo and Video Shoots during the inauguration and completion.
- b) Rs. 5000.00/- to the Co-Ordinator of the Training Program for organizing, monitoring and reporting of the Training Program.

The Photo Shoot and Video Shoot should cover the Inauguration, Valedictory functions and Training Sessions.

5 Operation of this MoU

5.1 Upon execution of this MoU, ICT Academy shall communicate to K.G College of Arts & Science, Coimbatore, the training schedules. There upon, the parties shall mutually discuss and agree on the operational terms based on which ICT Academy would offer its services.

6 Validity of this MoU

6.1 The validity of this MoU for the proposed Employability Skill Training would be 30th. September 2019 which is the scheduled to be completion date, from the date of signing. The MoU may be renewed on mutually agreed terms between the Parties.

6.2 The Parties shall enter into firm binding agreements on the areas which are not covered under this MoU. Upon the execution of such agreements, this MoU may be terminated. Both parties shall have the right to terminate this MoU if any of the party does not comply with its obligations under this MoU by issuing 30 days prior notice.

7 CONFIDENTIALITY

7.1 The Parties shall treat all information, documents, contents and materials pertaining to ICT Academy or to Gauhati University, Assam, provided under this MoU as confidential.

7.2 ICT Academy or to K.G College of Arts & Science, Coimbatore shall not disclose any aspect of any confidential information to any third party in any manner whatsoever other than in the normal course of agreed terms under this MoU.

7.3 The confidentiality of information shall survive the termination of this Agreement.

7.4 Upon the termination of this MoU, to K.G College of Arts & Science, Coimbatore, shall return all the contents, training materials and such other information provided by ICT Academy under this MoU duly without any undue delay and in cases where such information is not capable of being returned destroy the same and provide a certificate to that to ICT Academy.

- (a) Any breach of this Agreement by to K.G College of Arts & Science, Coimbatore
- (b) Any negligence on the part of to K.G College of Arts & Science, Coimbatore

10. NOTICES

10.1 All notices regarding this Agreement shall be by personal delivery or by certified or registered mail, postage prepaid, at the addresses as either of them may so provide by notice given to the other in the same manner.

11. GOVERNING LAW:

This MoU is made under and shall be governed by and construed under the laws of the Republic of India under the jurisdiction of the courts at Chennai.

12. ARBITRATION

In the event any of any claim, controversy, dispute or difference between Parties, arising out of or in connection with or in relation to this Agreement, either Party will be entitled refer the same to arbitration in accordance with the rules of arbitration of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. There shall be three arbitrators, one to be appointed by ICT Academy, the other to be appointed by to **K.G College of Arts & Science, Coimbatore** and the third to be appointed by the two arbitrators appointed by the Parties. The award of the arbitrators shall be final and binding on the Parties. The Arbitration proceedings shall be held at Chennai.



- Publishing party agrees to render its service for a processing fee **Rs.12,000/-** per paper. No other payments were agreed upon by both the parties.




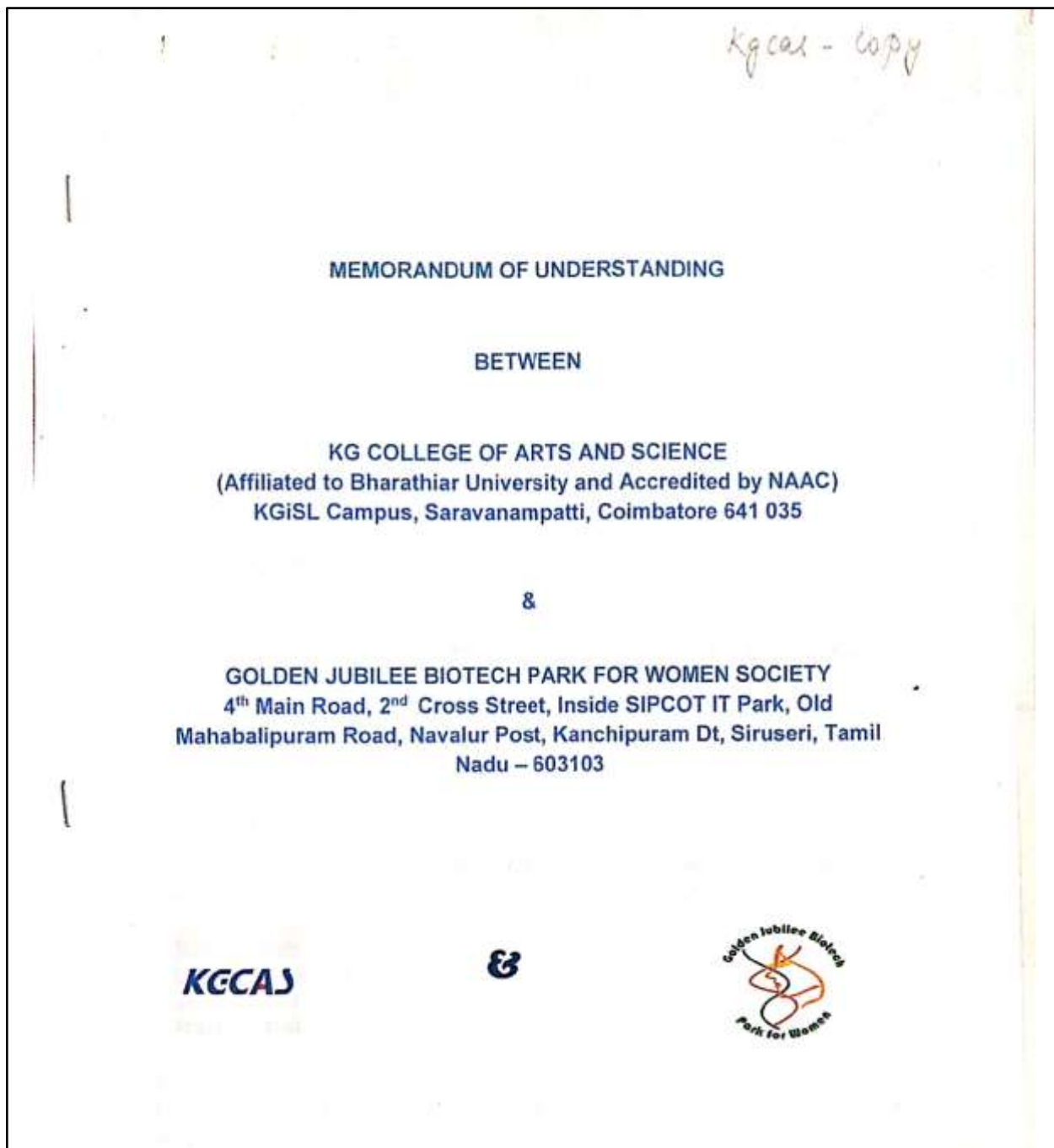

1. INTENT

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) establishes policies, procedures and scope for potential collaborative opportunities to enhance exchange of knowledge, expertise and information between the DEPARTMENT OF BIOTECHNOLOGY, STELLA MARIS COLLEGE (autonomous), 17, Cathedral Road, Chennai – 600 086 and GOLDEN JUBILEE BIOTECH PARK FOR WOMEN SOCIETY, Chennai registered as a Society under Tamil Nadu Societies Registration Act 1975, situated at 4th Main Road, 2nd Cross Street, Inside SIPCOT IT Park, Old Mahabalipuram Road, Navalur Post, Kanchipuram Dt, Siruseri, Tamil Nadu – 603103, in areas pertaining to biotechnology, biochemistry, agrotechnology, bioinformatics, molecular biology, microbiology, entrepreneurship and internship programmes. Through this MoU, both the parties express cooperation in capacity building, skill development, entrepreneurial training and participation in Research and Development.

2. BACKGROUND

KG COLLEGE OF ARTS AND SCIENCE was started in the year 2005 by the Founder & Director of KG Information Systems Private Limited Dr.Ashok Bakthavathsalam. He is the

man behind KGISL's growth by playing a key role in both leadership and management of the company.

- 3.3 The terms of cooperation for any other specific activities not contemplated under this MoU shall be mutually discussed and written down by both parties prior to the initiation of that particular activity. Any such activities agreed upon will be recorded and governed by a separate document executed by both parties.
- 3.4 The parties agree that MoUs of a similar of different nature can have arrangements with different institutions/organizations.

4. SUBSTANCE OF UNDERSTANDING

4.1 Information Sharing

The parties mutually agree to collaborate and facilitate a structured plan for the benefit of staff and students of the department through guest lectures, workshops, training programmes, projects and internships. The sharing of

information and knowledge will function under the principles of mutual understanding, common interest and complementary activities.

4.2 Scope of potential collaborative opportunities

Opportunities will be provided for Students and Staff of the Department to undertake projects and summer internship training programmes and to use the facilities and expertise through lab and field work.

Exchange of resource materials pertaining to academics and research.

Experiences and expertise in the fields of Biotechnology, Biochemistry, Agrotechnology, Bioinformatics, Molecular Biology, Microbiology, will be mutually exchanged and would be used for academic purposes and for societal benefits.

Scientists, academicians and resource persons will deliver guest lectures in areas of their specialization to students on days and timings pre-arranged on mutual consent.

Both the organizations will encourage visits and utilization of each other's research and technical facilities as and when required upon mutual consent.

4.3 Duration and Termination of the MoU

This MoU shall take effect upon signature by the authorities of both parties.

This MoU is valid from the Date of execution by the parties and shall remain in effect for a period of THREE YEARS with the mutual written agreement of both parties and may be amended at any time by written mutual consent.

Either party may terminate this MoU at any time without liability to the other on prior written notice of three months.

This MoU does not create binding, enforceable obligations against any party and all activities undertaken are subject to the availability of personnel, resources and funds, imposing no financial obligations on either party.

5. CONFIDENTIALITY, INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS AND ANNOUNCEMENTS

5.1 Each party agrees to maintain full confidentiality of any information disclosed or made available by the other under this MoU. Neither party shall use or disclose the confidential information of the other except to the extent required to enable the performance of this MoU.

5.2 Each party agrees to respect the Intellectual Property Rights of the other party. No licenses of Intellectual Property Rights are granted under this MoU and all such rights are reserved to the owning party (and/or its licensors, if applicable).


